No one ever believes that cancer or illness will strike their family and we certainly felt the same way. My younger sister Maureen was young, healthy and pregnant with the child that she and her husband had dreamed about when she was diagnosed with clear cell adenocarcinoma, a very rare and aggressive cervical cancer. This began Maureen's 19 month battle with cancer which would include numerous surgeries as well as very intensive and aggressive chemotherapy and radiation treatments at Sloan Kettering Hospital in New York City.

After a courageous fight, Maureen lost her battle with cancer on January 19, 2003 at the young age of 31. Throughout her journey she never gave up hope and that unbinding hope would become one of the most valuable gifts that she would leave me.

Beads of Courage

Beads of Courage is a new program Maureen's Hope is sponsoring at the Golisiano Children's Hospital in Syracuse. Children are given a length of string and beads that spell out their first name.



Then colorful beads, each representing a different treatment milestone, are given to the child by their nurse or health care provider to add to their Beads of Courage collection.

The beads become a tangible way for children battling cancer to tell their story with each bead representing a different and meaningful symbol of courage.



You and Me Bears

These bears are given to children in the hospital to share with a parent or sibling during times they may have to be apart. They are a simple reminder of the love they share.
